Requirements for Students with Diabetes

Students with a diagnosis of diabetes must provide the nurse with the following - one to two weeks prior to the first day of classes each year.

I. Supplies to be provided by parent/guardian:

Glucometer (with supply of test strips)
Insulin and syringes
2 Glucose Gel tubes
1 full bottle Glucose Tabs
6-12 Juice Boxes (15 carb size)
Crackers
Glucagon kit (expiration date after end of school year)
Ketone strips
